Dear Felton Family,

First, let me begin by stating that our first priority at Felton Laboratory Charter School is protecting the health and safety of our students, faculty, staff, and families and maintaining a teaching and learning environment that is as close to normal as possible. The 2020 – 2021 calendar states that all students will return to campus on Monday, July 20, 2020. Recently, we sent you a survey requesting your input regarding how children should return to school. Based on the results of the survey, input from the Leadership Team and guidelines established by the South Carolina AccelerateED Task Force, it has been decided that for the month of July (Monday, July 20 – Friday, July 31, 2020), we will continue providing instructional virtually to our students. This will allow us the opportunity to ensure that all safety precautions are addressed and are ready to be enforced before students return to our campus. Students will need their laptops to participate in virtual learning. In order for students to pick up their laptops, you will need to be fully admitted to Felton Laboratory Charter School and the following technology forms will need to be filled out and returned to us by 5:00 PM Friday, July 17, 2020. The required forms are:

- Felton Laboratory Charter School/South Carolina State University Use of Computers/Internet and Electronic Mail Form.
- Felton Laboratory Charter School Internet/Network User Agreement 2020 - 2021 Form.
- Felton Laboratory Student Chromebook Agreement Form.

We will also have the forms available for you to fill out during the virtual learning pick-up. Students who have not completed the technology forms or have not returned their laptop from the 2019 – 2020 school year will receive an instructional learning packet.

On Friday, July 17, 2020 from 9:00AM – 5:00PM and Saturday, July 18, 2020 from 9:00AM – 12:00PM, you will have the opportunity to pick up your instructional learning packet or your laptop. We are currently reviewing the SC DHEC data to make a decision about school for the month of August. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the school.
